

Example approaches to recommendations:

Limited detail:

Recommendation 1a: The California Task Force on Family Caregiving recommends that the Legislature pass a tax credit for the out-of-pocket costs of family caregiving.

This credit should be no less than \$5,000 per year per household. Eligibility criteria for this credit should be limited so that it may serve prevent middle-income caregivers from descending into poverty, with eligibility capped for households making \$200,000 or more. Under this provision, caregivers for recipients with an income exceeding 150% of Federal Poverty Rate would be ineligible.
